Rector's Reflections



Dear Friends,

At first, the pandemic seemed like a sprint. We were going to throw everything we had into getting to the finish line, which we thought, or at least I thought, would be somewhere around Pentecost. On Pentecost Sunday, I and many others hoped, we would be back in the church with baptism and trumpets, singing our hearts out as we regathered.

As it turns out, pandemic life is a marathon, albeit one none of us prepared for or wanted to run. We are creating a new normal, parts of which will be with us for a long time to come. We have reached new people with our online worship offerings and I doubt we will ever cease to livestream our services. We are learning new ways to connect with each other and pray together. Our patience and perseverance is being tried, but our trust in God is growing as we keep putting one foot in front of the other. We are finding creative ways to support those less fortunate in the world around us. And we are learning to pace ourselves, taking one day at a time and focusing on what we can do now rather than what we can do when the pandemic is over.

God's people have often found themselves in a marathon rather than a sprint. (Think 40 days on the ark, 40 years in the wilderness, decades in exile in Babylon...). And every time, God's people experienced God's presence with them, learned to worship in new ways, and emerged from the marathon with a deepened understanding of their identity and call as children of God. My hope, trust, and prayer is that this marathon is such a time for us.

Resuming In-Person Worship at Christ Church

At the June 30 vestry meeting, the vestry made the difficult decision to continue with the suspension of in-person worship through the month of July. This decision was based on the survey responses, many of which indicated that people are not yet comfortable returning to church, as well as the current situation in which cases of Covid-19 are rising at an alarming rate in Ohio.

The plan, as you will see on the August Calendar, is to begin an 8am Sunday morning service in the memorial garden in August. That service will be the same one that is streamed at 10:30 minus the music. Masks and social distancing will be required. The garden will hold about 12 people depending on how many households are represented. There will be a sign up for each service that will be posted online in the next week or two. People who are interested in the service will be asked to sign up for one Sunday to make it possible for as many to attend as possible through out the month. More information will be coming soon.

June Vestry Meeting Highlights




- The vestry met on Tuesday, June 30 via Zoom and began the meeting with prayer and Bible Study.
- The end of May financials show good pledge giving, but we are down in plate offering (obviously) and rental income. May's pledge income was boosted by one family/person who paid their pledge for the rest of the year in May.
- The vestry voted to give bonuses to Kathy Garber, Mario Buchanan, Sarah Bhatia, and Susie Vanaman in thanksgiving for the extraordinary efforts they have made to keeping our life at Christ Church running smoothly during the pandemic.
- After much discussion, the vestry voted to continue with the suspension of in-person worship through July because Covid-19 numbers continue to climb in Ohio. The plan is to have an outdoor service each Sunday in August at 8am (weather permitting) with all precautions in place (physical distancing of 6 feet between households, mask requirement, no music or passing of the peace, or coffee hour).
- The vestry will meet again on July 15 at 6pm to review the plans for the building project and make a determination about moving forward.

A Quiz about our Noack Organ!

In our archives, we have the design drawings from the organ builder for our pipe organ.

There is a slight difference between the initial design and how our pipe organ looks now.

Can you spot the difference?

THE ANSWER: If you look at the façade (the visible pipes on display), you can see that the roof line was originally suppose to be curved but the organ now has straight beams. The same can be seen on the sides of the organ case, where the corners are more pointed rather than curved. According to correspondences in the archives, right before the contract was to be signed with the Noack Organ Company there was a strong objection to the top of the organ case being curved and instead wanted the roof line to follow the straight outer tower molding. Mr. Noack hastily made a few new drawings while he was out and sent them off, which were accepted by the organ committee. Another interesting note is that there was first talk about the instrument being turned 90 degrees from its original spot to be facing out into the congregation and even it being in the rear balcony.
